Guidelines

- Must be able to work with schools in Anne Arundel County, Maryland.
 - Artists may submit up to three (3) programs for their listing.
 - The annual directory listing fee is \$10.00
 - Returning applicants: if you are currently listed in our directory and your listing does not need any updates you will still need to fill out an application.
 - First-time applicants: if you are a new artist and are not currently listed on the roster of the Maryland State Arts Council, Young Audiences, and/or Artivate then at least three references and letters of support from school districts you have worked with will need to be provided.
- Note: This does not guarantee a listing in the directory.*
- Directory applications must be submitted by August 30, 2021, 11:59PM EST
